*This used to be the Fricks' fancy room for holidays and parties.*

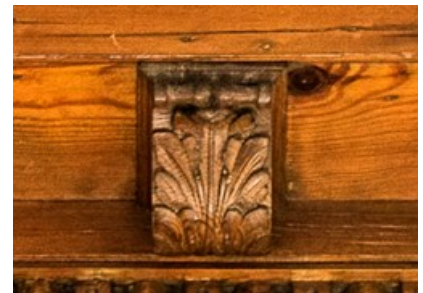
**Fun fact!** The wood used in this room was imported, or brought over, from a very old home in England.
